Schuyler Meyers is an artist living in Maine.

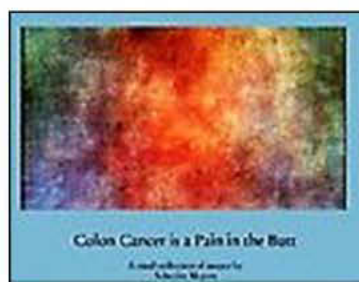
Early December of 2011, he went in for a colonoscopy. Because he is only 49 years old, he was told that there were usually three outcomes to this procedure: 1) they would find nothing and tell him to come back in ten years; 2) they would find a few polyps, snip them off, and tell him to come back in five years; 3) they would find a lot of polyps and tell him to come back in three years.

They told him to come back in a week.

Schuyler had a cat scan, met with an oncologist, and a surgeon who showed him the pictures of the nasty stage-3 cancer growing in his upper colon. Needless to say, Schuyler immediately underwent a partial colectomy. Early reports are that if all goes well he should be okay within a year, albeit with a much shorter colon.

Schuyler is without steady employment. He is trying to come up with creative ways to raise funds for his treatment. So he created a "coffee-table" book, of sorts, containing selections of his artwork as inspired by his battle with cancer.

Buying his book, *Colon Cancer is a Pain in the Butt*, is one way to help Schuyler raise funds to cover upcoming which will make it difficult for him to receive the treatment he needs.



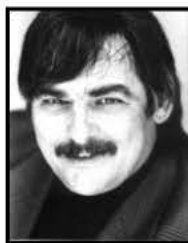

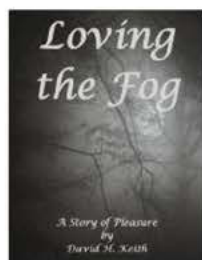
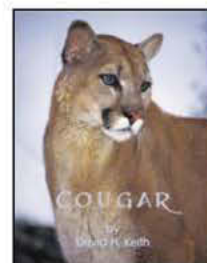

His works of adventure and erotica can be found on Smashwords.

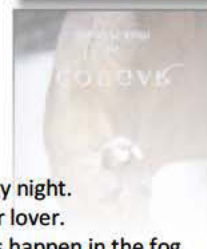
Cougar
